1. This Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations.
2. Entries must be made on or before Monday, 12th March, 1973 (Postmark).

3. The Show opens at 11.00 a.m. Judging will commence at 12.00 noon. Show closes at 5.00 p.m.
4. All dogs must be at the Show by 12.00 noon on Saturday, 7th April, 1973, except through very exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Manager, which may be granted up to 1.15 p.m. at the Exhibitor's own risk. All charges by rail to be prepaid by the exhibitors.
5. Exhibitors' passes as per Kennel Club Show Regulation 10a.
6. Admission to Visitors 20p. Accompanied Children 10p. Catalogue 15p.
7. An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in OUR DOGS or DOG WORLD of any alteration or addition made to the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
8. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries for or at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations and by these Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
9. All dogs must be registered or transferred at the Kennel Club before the Show (vide Kennel Club Rule 5).
10. Puppies under six calendar months of age are not eligible for exhibition.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

THE FAUDEL-PHILLIPS CUP re-presented by Mrs. Fullerton for Best Black Dog over 12 months old. To be won 5 times.

MISSIE TOPSIDE MEMORIAL BOWL re-presented by the late Mrs. Manooch for Best Bitch in Limit Class. To be won 3 times. 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners only to compete.

BLUE SHEBA OF KANG SHI CUP represented by the late Mrs. Manooch for Best Blue Chow. To be won 5 times.

NOVICE CUP re-presented by the late Mrs. Manooch, to be won five times in succession, seven times in all, by Best Novice Dog or Bitch, any colour.

THE MONTIFIORE CUP re-presented by the late Lady Faudel-Phillips for Best Dog in Mid Limit Class. To be won three times by same exhibitor, not necessarily the same dog.

CHALLENGE BASKET, re-presented by the late Mrs. Manooch for Best Dog. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners only eligible to compete. (Perpetual)

CH. YOU SI BOWL re-presented by Mrs. T.J. Painting for Best Blue Dog in Show. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize-winners only eligible to compete. (Perpetual)

THE ADEL CUP presented by the late Miss Buckley for Best Bitch any other colour than Red. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners only eligible to compete. To be won 5 times

by the same exhibitor.

AKBAR CUP presented by Miss Peck for Best Puppy Dog or Bitch. Bred by Exhibitor. To be won 3 times in succession or times in all by same owner. (1st, 2nd, 3rd prizewinners

CHINESE CHALLENGE CUP presented by the Chinese Chow Club for Best Dog any other colour than Red. To be won 5 times by the same exhibitor.

CHINESE CHALLENGE CUP presented by the Chinese Chow Club for Best Bitch any other colour than Red. To be won 5 times by the same exhibitor.

CUP presented by Miss Faudel-Phillips for Best Junior Dog or Bitch. To be won three times by the same exhibitor.

CUP presented by the Countess of Kilmorey for Best Black Bitch. (Perpetual)

CUP presented by the late Miss Buckley for Best Smooth Chow Dog. To be won 5 years in succession or 5 times in all not more than twice by the same animal.

CUP presented by the late Mrs. Shacklock for Best Smooth Chow Bitch. To be won 3 years in succession or 5 times in all not more than twice by the same animal. Re-presented by Mr. & Mrs. Burrows as a perpetual trophy.

CUP presented by the late Miss Buckley in memory of Ch. Mandarin of Adel for Best Self-Red Dog. To be competed for at each Show.

CUP presented by Mrs. Clarke for Best Bitch in Graduate Class in memory of The Countess of Changy. Not to be won outright.

BUCKLEY MEMORIAL SALVER for Best Puppy in Show (Perpetual)

CHINESE CHOW CLUB CHALLENGE CUP to be awarded to Best Graduate Dog (Perpetual)

CUP to be won outright for Best Black Dog. Presented by Lady Royle.

#### DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(Vide Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

The word "dog" includes both sexes.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' Classes or competing for Members' Specials, each member of such partnership must, at the time of entry, be a member of the Club.

In estimating the number of prizes won, all wins previous to the midnight preceding the day specified in the Schedule for closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes but when entering for Variety Classes wins in both Breed or Variety classes must be counted. A Variety Class is one in which more than one Breed or variety of a Breed can compete. A First Prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value.

NOTE: In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any award that counts towards the title of Championship under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

With these provisos the following are the Definitions of certain classes:

PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

UNIOR For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

NOVICE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes each of the value of £1. or more (Puppy and Special Puppy classes excluded).

GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes, each of the value of £2. or more in Post Graduate, Mid Limit, Minor Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not.

#### POST GRADUATE

For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes, each of the value of £2. or more in Post Graduate, Mid Limit, Minor Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not.

#### MID LIMIT

For dogs which have not won three Challenge Certificates or five or more First Prizes in a limit of the value of £2. or more, in Mid Limit Limit and Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

#### LIMIT

For dogs which have not won three different judges or seven or more First Prizes in all, each of the value of £2. or more, in Limit and Open Classes confined to the breed whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

#### OPEN

For all dogs of the breeds or varieties for which a class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

#### SPECIAL NOVICE

Same as Novice but restricted as to colour.

#### SPECIAL OPEN

Same as Open but restricted as to colour.

#### VETERAN

For dogs of seven years of age or over on the day of the Show.
