Throughout the world of Chows

the name of Mrs. Dulcie Smith and her Hanoi Kennels is well known. Mrs. Smith has bred and exported many dogs who have subsequently brought fame to their breeder by becoming Champions in their new homeland, amongst those the two bitches who had excellent show careers Int.Ch.Chin Yu of Hanoi & Int.Ch.Tai Yo of Hanoi. Nor.Ch.Hanoi Hobey & Ch.Hanoi Mary Lou, Finnish Ch. Hanoi Yasou, Swed.Ch.Hanoi Texas Topper of Taibel, Can.Ch. Hanoi Samson, S.A.Ch.Hanoi Copper King & Am.& Can.Ch.Hanoi Tiko Topper. Her own Ch.Tiko Ling of Hanoi sired many Champions, those that lived with her being Ch.Hanoi Damon & Ch.Tsu. Mrs. Smith keeps about 10 Chows all of whom live in the house together, amongst those being Ch.Hanoi Hi There & Ch.Hanoi Willie Wumpkins who always sleeps beside his mistress' bed. She saw her first Chow in a hairdressing salon where she worked, she says she went down on her knees to speak to him and Chows have kept her there ever since. Her first Chow was acquired in 1936, she won her first C.C. with Brutus of Ho-Ping in 1941 and first awarded C.C.'s in the early 50's.

BITCHES - MRS.S.JAKEMAN

Mrs. Jakeman bought her first Chow in 1966 as a pet. She then acquired a black bitch from Mrs. Painting and the following year when Miss Buckley died bought Jean of Adel, a daughter of Ch.Tiko Ling and pure Adel on the dams side. These two bitches founded the Tanlap Kennels where there are 14 red and black chows in permanent residence. She has been exhibiting consistently since 1968, winning 3 R.C.C.'s with her dog Tanlap Black Thunder whose daughter Ch.Tanlap Tamanda she made up in 1975. Recently she has been seen in the show ring with the red puppy, Tristar, who gained his Junior Warrant in seven weeks. The most successful exports from this Kennel being Int.Ch.Tressta & Int.Ch.Tamerglow in Norway, N.Z.Ch.T.Tango & T.Typhoon. Mrs. Jakeman commenced judging in 1972 and has judged Open Shows for the National, Midland and N.E.Chow Clubs; has been a committee member of the Chow Chow Club for 7 years and is currently Cup Steward for that Club.

REFEREE - MR. GEORGE WEBSTER who bought his first Chow in the 1920's to guard his motor cycle and side car whilst he was racing at Brooklands. He first started exhibiting his Hampfield Chows during the war years at a Red Cross Show at Kew. Of recent years the activities of the kennels have been curtailed but he still has a faithful blue dog as companion. Hon.Life Member of

the Chow Chow Club and Vice-President of the Chow Club of Wales. His services as a Referee are much valued.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This Show will be held under K.C.Rules & Show Regulations. Entries must be made on or before 19th March 1979 (Postmark). The Show opens at 10.a.m. Judging will commence at 10.30.a.m. Show closes at 5.p.m. Early removals from 3.p.m. All dogs must be at the show by 10.30.a.m. on Sunday 22nd April 1979 except through very exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Manager, which may be granted up to noon at the Exhibitor's own risk. All charges by rail to be prepaid by the exhibitors. Exhibitors passes will not be sent. For acknowledgment of entries please enclose a stamped addressed envelope. Admission to Visitors 30p. Accompanied children 15p. Catalogue 40p. An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in OUR DOGS or DOG WORLD of any alteration or addition made to the Schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries for or at this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by K.C.Rules & Show Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received. All dogs must be registered or transferred at the Kennel Club before the show (Vide K.C.Rule 5) Puppies under 6 calendar months of age are not eligible for exhibition. THE MATING OF BITCHES WITHIN THE PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW IS FORBIDDEN.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

The word DOG includes both sexes. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members classes or competing for Members Specials, each member of such partnership must, at the time of entry, be a Member of such Association, Club or Society. In estimating the number of prizes won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries (11th March)

NEW AMENDMENT

- Wins at Championship Shows in Breed classes where C.C.'s are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows

MINOR PUPPY for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 9 calendar months of age on day of show
PUPPY for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 12 calendar months of age on day of show
JUNIOR for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 18 calendar months of age on day of show
NOVICE for dogs which have not won a C.C. or 3 or more First prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Puppy, SP.Puppy, Minor & Sp.Minor Puppy classes excepted)

GRADUATE for dogs which have not won a C.C. or 4 or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Postgraduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes whether restricted or not.
SPECIAL GRADUATE - as Graduate but restricted as to colour.

POSTGRADUATE for dogs which have not won a C.C. or 5 or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Postgraduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes whether restricted or not.
MID LIMIT for dogs which have not won 3 Challenge Certificates

in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit & Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where C.C.'s were offered to the breed.
LIMIT for dogs which have not won 3 C.C.'s under 3 different judges or 7 or more First prizes in all at Championship shows in Limit & Open classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not at shows where C.C.'s were offered for the breed.
SPECIAL OPEN - as Open but restricted as to colour

OPEN for all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show.
VETERAN for dogs of 8 (eight) years of age or over on the day of show.
SPECIAL OPEN - LADY ROYLE MEMORIAL STAKES - Owner, handler or Dog, never to have won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate in the breed.
