RULES AND SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations in force at time of publication of Schedule.
2. All entries must be made on or before Monday, 16th JULY, 1973 (POSTMARK) on forms enclosed for that purpose. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. If acknowledgment of entries is required, please enclose stamped addressed envelope.
4. The entrance fee of a dog entered but not sent to the Show will be forfeited.
5. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse, on reasonable grounds, any entries.
6. The Committee is empowered to exclude or remove any dog which, in the opinion of the Veterinary Surgeon of the Show is not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, vice or any other cause.
7. The Show will open at 1.00 p.m. and judging will commence at 2.00 p.m.
8. No dogs will be received after 2.30 p.m. except under exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Manager.
9. An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in OUR DOGS or DOG WORLD of any alteration or addition to the Schedule shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
10. The Committee will not in any way be responsible for any claim for injury or compensation by or arising out of the holding of this Show, or by reason or the act of default of any person in attendance or present thereat.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

(Vide Kennel Club Regulations for Definition of Classes) N.B. The word "Dog" includes both sexes.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' Classes or competing for Members' specials, each member of such partnership must, at the time of entry, be a member of the Club.

Puppies under six calendar months of age are not eligible for exhibition.

In estimating the number of prizes won, all wins previous to the midnight preceding the day specified in the Schedule for closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any Class.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes and a win not dependent on judging by breed points does not count. A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed can compete. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

With this proviso the following are the definitions of certain classes:

PUPPY

For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

JUNIOR

For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

NOVICE

For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes each of the value of £1. or more (Puppy and Special Puppy Classes excepted).

GRADUATE:

For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes each of the value of £2. or more in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, whether restricted or not.

LIMIT

For dogs which have not won three Challenge Certificates under three different Judges or seven or more First Prizes in all, each of the value of £2. or more in Limit and Open Classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN

For all dogs. If confined to a breed or variety for all dogs of that breed or variety.

SPECIAL NOVICE

Same as Novice, but restricted as to Colour.

SPECIAL OPEN

Same as Open, but restricted as to Colour.
