SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. This Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules & Show Regs.
2. Entries must be made on or before Monday 10th July 1978.
3. First Class Post advisable.
3. The Show opens at 10.30a.m. Judging commences at 11.30a.m. Show closes 3.30p.m. Early removal 2.30p.m. over 100 miles.
4. All dogs must be at the show by 11.30a.m. on Sunday 6th August 1978 except through very exceptional circumstances and by permission of the Show Manager which may be granted up to 12 noon at the Exhibitors own risk. All charges by rail to be paid by the exhibitor.
5. Admission to non-exhibitors 30p. Accompanied children 15p Catalogue 30p
6. An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in OUR DOGS or DOG WORLD of any alteration or addition to the Schedule or in the

notice thereof.

Every exhibitor making an entry or entries for or at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regs and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

All dogs must be registered or transferred at the Kennel Club before the show (Vide Rule 5)

Puppies under 6 months of age are not eligible for exhibition.

The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is strictly forbidden.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Dogs born after 1.4.76 must be registered on the ACTIVE list to be exhibited. Please give ACTIVE REG.NO. or ARAF (Active Reg.applied for) or NAF or TAF below the dogs name on the entry form if not yet returned from the Kennel Club. The word DOG includes both sexes.

**NOTE** In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any award that counts to the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and competing for Members Specials or in Members classes, each Member of such partnership must at the time of entry be a Member of this Club.

In estimating the number of prizes won all wins previous to 2nd

July 1978 shall be counted when entering for any class. Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed classes. A Variety Class is one in which more than one Breed or Variety of Breed can compete.

**MINOR PUPPY** for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 9 calendar months of age on day of show

**PUPPY** for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 12 calendar months of age on day of show

**JUNIOR** for dogs of 6 and not exceeding 18 calendar months of age on day of show

**NOVICE** for dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or 3 or more 1st prizes at Open & Championship Shows (Sp.Puppy, Puppy, Minor & Sp.Minor puppy classes excepted)

**GRADUATE** for dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or 4 or more 1st prizes at Championship shows in Graduate, Post-graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes whetehr restricted or not.

**LIMIT** for dogs which have not won 3 Challenge Certificates under

3 different judges or 7 or more 1st prizes in all at Championship shows in Limit and Open classes confined to the breed

whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN for all dogs of the breeds or varieties for which the class is prohibited and eligible for entry at the Show.

SPECIAL GRADUATE as for Graduate with restrictions as to colour

SPECIAL OPEN as for Open with restrictions as to colour

VETERAN for dogs of 8 (eight) years of age or over on the day of show.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS

Owner, handler or dog never to have won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate in the breed.
